Atrophic Samples & Their Evaluation in Surepath Samples

This is a one day course aimed specifically at the problem area of atrophy. The morning session comprises an introductory lecture and multiheader session outlining the features of both normal and abnormal groups. After lunch there will be a slide workshop giving participants the opportunity to see lots of abnormal and benign cases at their own speed, together with a small self assessment element. Full multiheader review of these unknowns completes the session.

Participants are encouraged to bring cases from their own laboratories for this day.

Learning Outcomes

At the end of the session participants should;

- Understand the causes of atrophy
- Be aware of the effect atrophy has on the cervix
- Be familiar with the variation in cytological patterns of atrophy
- Be aware of the difficulties atrophy presents to visual search mechanisms
- Be able to recognise the characteristics of normal atrophic samples
- Be able to recognise the characteristics of abnormal cells and cell groups
- Be aware of the value of HPV triage in this age group
- Be able to correctly identify abnormal samples from selected test sets
