The North of England Pathology and Screening Education Centre (NEPSEC) is located on the Wakefield Office Village development in the North Quadrant of Silkwood Park. Silkwood Park is situated immediately off junction 40 of the M1 motorway providing excellent accessibility to the region.

Directions to the training centre by car

From the East or West follow M62 to Junction 29 and take M1 South, then follow M1 South to Junction 40 sign posted A638 Wakefield/Dewsbury



From the North follow M1 South to Junction 40 and take the first exit signposted A638 Wakefield



From the South follow M1 North to Junction 40 and take the third exit signposted A638 Wakefield





After joining the A638 towards Wakefield, take the first left turn signposted Flanshaw Trading Estate/Silkwood Park



At the roundabout take the second exit onto Fryers Way. You should have Ramada Hotel on your right hand side.





After joining Fryers Way, take the first left turn into Wakefield Office Village.



The training centre is Unit 3 and has designated parking spaces to the side of the building.





Directions to the training centre on foot from the nearby hotels

As car park spaces at the training centre are limited, If you are staying in one of the nearby hotels, you are advised to leave your car in the hotel car park and walk to the training centre. The centre is a short walk from both Ramada Wakefield and also Holiday Inn Express Wakefield.

From the **Ramada Wakefield** cross the car park to the road, which is named Fryers Way. Turn right and then turn left onto Wakefield Office Village.



From the **Holiday Inn Express Wakefield** entrance/exit cross the road and turn right up to the traffic lights. Cross the main road (A638) and turn left.





Follow the road to the next traffic lights, turn left signposted Flanshaw Trading Estate/Silkwood Park and continue to the roundabout before turning right onto Fryers Way









Take the first left onto Wakefield Office Village



Satellite Navigation

Use postcode WF5 9TJ, which will take you to Westgate Court, which is the office park opposite Wakefield Office Village.

Parking

Free limited car parking is available at Unit 3 Wakefield Office Village adjacent to the building. Spaces will be allocated on a first come first served basis. Please note the parking spaces are marked as 'NEPSEC'. Parking permits are **not** required.

Arriving by Rail

The nearest train station is **Wakefield Westgate** with services run from the south via London Kings Cross and north to Leeds and further North to York, Newcastle and Scotland. It also serves trains from Birmingham and the South West. Trains services from the East and North West are served via Leeds station.

The station is manned with an information kiosk, ticket office, cashpoint, refreshments and a newsagent. Snacks and drinks are also available from vending machines on the station platform. A taxi rank is available outside the station, advanced booking is not normally necessary, unless arriving early in the morning or late at night.

The taxi should take around 10 minutes depending on traffic and you should expect to pay approximately £10 (Satellite Navigation Code is WF5 9TJ). Below you will find some contact details for local taxi businesses:

Wakefield has a second station, **Wakefield Kirkgate** with services running from Knottingley, Sheffield and Nottingham. The station is a nice clean station, which is security manned with a small shop for refreshments. There is no ticket office, but there are ticket machines. There is no taxi rank outside the station, so advanced booking using the details below is strongly recommended.

An alternative route for those traveling from the west is to alight at **Dewsbury Station**, which is just 4 miles from the training centre, and take a taxi avoiding the need to travel into Leeds and out to Wakefield Westgate.

By Bus

From Wakefield Westgate catch the bus service 268A (Wakefield to Bradford) and inform the driver that you need to alight at the Malt Shovel Public House at Lupset. From here it is an approximately 8-10 minutes walk to NEPSEC using the following directions:

- Walk in a north-westerly direction (towards M1) along A638
- · After 120m, turn right into Goldsmith Avenue
- Take the footpath towards the entrance of the Total Fitness gym
- Cross the gym carpark towards its entrance gates onto Fryers Way
- Walking away from the gym entrance gates take the first right turn into Wakefield Office Village
- Arrive at NEPSEC, Unit 3 Wakefield Office Village
