Invasive lesions

This full day session is dedicated to invasive lesions, both squamous and glandular. The morning lecture will cover the background of cervical cancer and will include some basic epidemiology and up to date statistics on incidence and mortality. It will also cover the basic features of cancer in both histology and cytology and will include some cases from the NHSCSP cancer audit.

The multi-head microscopy session will cover the basic cytological features and give some clues into correctly predicting cancer and more importantly into not missing it altogether.

The afternoon will be a self-assessment set with full a multi-head review session.

Learning Outcomes

At the end of the session individuals should;

- Be aware of recent cancer statistics
- Be aware of the histological appearances of cancer
- Demonstrate an understanding of the relevant cytological features of invasion and be able to separate these from CIN and entities such as repair
- Be aware of the pitfalls of cancer and the possible false negative diagnosis
- Be aware of some of the more unusual types of cancer
- Have a basic understanding of staging and survival
