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### **Squamous Dyskaryosis ‘Difficulties and Challenges’**

A full day covering difficult and challenging aspects of squamous dyskaryosis including mimics and pitfalls. The day will start with a lecture looking at basic morphology and common pitfalls. It will also include a refresher on the role of HPV in the development of cervical cancer. This will be followed by a workshop session of difficult and challenging cases at the participants own microscope. In the afternoon participants will have the opportunity to review a workshop of unknown cases at their microscopes, this will be followed by feedback and multihead review.

***Participants are encouraged to bring along difficult/contentious/interesting cases for discussion on the multihead in the afternoon.***

The day closes with an assessment of learning outcomes (10 fairly straight forward questions) followed by answers and group discussion.

- Be reminded of the typical features of squamous dyskaryosis and their mimics
- Be able to better recognise and identify difficult presentations of squamous dyskaryosis
- Be able to separate cases of squamous dyskaryosis from their typical mimics
- Be able to improve their sensitivity and specificity for squamous lesions
- Be aware of the role of HPV in the development of cervical cancer
