A Three-Day Update Course for Consultant Biomedical Scientists

This three day course is aimed at Consultant Biomedical Scientists, but is also open to those in training for that role and to medical staff. The course satisfies NHSCSP requirements for mandatory training. The course includes sessions on cervical histopathology, recent developments in colposcopy, discussion on the development of HPV testing within the primary HPV pilot sentinel sites, the NHSCSP invasive cancer audit, an overview of HPV technologies, experiences from the HPV sentinel sites and a lecture on the possibilities for self-sampling.

There are a number of multiheader sessions where participants bring their own slides for discussion. This has the advantage of allowing inclusion of both Thinprep[®] and Surepath[™] technologies and allows for excellent case discussion. Interspersed between these microscopy sessions are a number of lectures where there is also time allotted for debate and discussion.

There are also many opportunities to debate and discuss local practice with other course participants and almost as much can be learned from informal discussions as from the formal presentations and workshops.
