## **Histopathology Reporting Exam Preparation Day for Healthcare Scientists**

This day has been put together specifically for those working towards or contemplating the stage C part of the reporting qualification.

The day has been put together by successful candidates in both the stage A and C examinations plus consultant histopathologist RCPATH examiners. There are GI and gynae modules which will run concurrently.

This is an exam preparation course. There will be advice and useful hints and tips from those that have taken the examinations, with sessions on all of the components of the examination, including macros and management scenarios. This is not a morphology course, but participants will undertake a mock exam based around cases that might easily appear in the exam and then receive feedback on their performance.

### **Learning Outcomes**

At the end of the day individuals should;

- Be aware of the type of question and case that might be encountered in the exam.
- Have received advice and guidance on how to approach the questions and tasks
- Be aware of the importance of good clinicopathological correlation.
- Be aware of the type of case that might be encountered and advice on how best to approach the answer
- Be more confident on the day of the examination
- Be aware of the format of the examination, and its components

### **Venue**

This course is operated from our Wakefield site.

The centre is situated in a commercial site in Silkwood Park close to Junction 40 of the M1. We are 20 miles from Leeds Bradford airport, 13 miles from Leeds City railway station and just 2 miles from both Wakefield railway stations.
