Squamous Dyskaryosis – How to Spot the Difficult Stuff!

The day starts with a presentation covering the basics of abnormal squamous lesions. This will be followed by a workshop session where participants will be presented with a series of unknown cases for review on their own microscopes followed by full multiheaded review of all the cases.

The afternoon also includes a second lecturing concentrating on the difficult areas of small cell dyskaryosis and hyperchromatic crowded groups that will make use of the interactive voting system. We finish with the learning assessment. 10 fairly straightforward questions to check you have been listening with the answers and group discussion.
