## HPV primary screening, principles, practice and effects

This course is designed to fulfil the requirements of both an update workshop and existing HPV primary screening roll out guidance.

The evidence base for the move to HPV primary screening will be discussed along with potential benefits and pitfalls involved in the change of technology.

Evidence from pilot sites will be presented and current national guidance discussed in terms of case scenarios.

The workshop element is aimed at encouraging staff to consider the effect of knowing the HPV status on the way cytologists report.

The second lecture will debate the potential wider effects of the move to HPV primary screening on those services involved in cervical screening.

Cases will be either ThinPrep™ or SurePath® as required by the student.

- Be reminded of the typical features of some of the common pitfalls seen in squamous, and endocervical abnormalities and how these differ from normal findings.
