## **Scientist Reporting Exam Preparation Day**

This day has been put together specifically for those working towards the scientist reporting qualification and approaching or contemplating undertaking their stage A examination.

The day has been put together by Jo Horne & Karen Ezard who have experience in both the part A & part C examination with the support of consultant histopathologists who are college examiners .

There are GI, Gynae and Skin modules which will run concurrently.

This is an exam preparation course. There will be advice and useful hints and tips from those that have taken the examinations along with a session around submitting a successful portfolio but it is not a morphology course. Participants will undertake a mock examination based around cases that might easily appear in the exam and then receive feedback on their performance.

### **Learning Outcomes**

At the end of the respective days individuals should;

- Be aware of the type of question and case that might be encountered in the exam.
- Have received advice and guidance on how to approach the questions and tasks
- Be aware of the importance of good clinicopathological correlation
- Be aware of the type of case that might be encountered and advice on how best to approach the answer
- Be more confident on the day of the examination

### **Venue**

This course is operated from our Wakefield site.
